#### **WATER WELLS:**

Unicef estimates 800 children die daily from water born illnesses. The village of Glikpo gathered water 3 km away from them, in a pond that was filled with disease and animal excrement. Through your help we were able to provide the AG church in Glikpo with a water well which provides clean safe water to the community everyday. What difference does good health makes to a village?

#### **TRAINING:**

Perhaps the most important aspect of working with West African Pastors is providing training. These pastors interact with each other, and the materials they are given, allowing themselves to be changed by the truths taught. The result is discipleship which leads to explosive growth in the community. Spiritual formation is a good way of describing what training means to an African pastor.

#### **TABERNACLES:**

These simple metal structures (46'X35') provide shade from the sun and shelter from the rain. Local pastors finish the structure to their liking, allowing "buy in" from the community. Tabernacles increase evangelism because the work mobilizes the community to work with the local church and pastor. We build "Tabs" to build people- the work always outlasts the structure.
