Lasting fruit. Lord, as You have promised, grant my shepherd lasting fruit. Let those who believe in You through his/her ministry grow in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ. May they become disciples who disciple others []n. 15:16; Col. 2:6-7; 2 Tim. 2:2).

Fear of God. Lord, keep my pastor in the fear of You. Bind the fear of failure and people. Give my pastor boldness to confront sin and other threats to the church. Enable _____ to remain confident, even when others resist the gospel or his/her vision. Honor _____ 's stand for You, and come to the rescue when others oppose him/her (Prov. 19:23; Jn. 14:1; Heb. 12:3; Psalm 35).
